Introduction

The present course is to combine (a) English majors, with (2) the theory of Natural Approach (Krashen and Terrell, 1983), and (3) the application of current issue topics, cultural and personal interests, and to allow course participants to freely choose their area of interests to present their thoughts and ideas in a carefree environment/setting while the course instructor provides input and assistance when necessary.

The purposes of the course include: (a) to investigate difficulties and needs of English learning, oral in specific, of English majors; (b) to investigate difficulties of English teaching, oral in specific, to English majors; (c) to investigate the effectiveness of the use of Natural Approach to teach English to English majors; and (e) to evaluate the accomplishment of the use of Natural Approach in teaching English oral skills to English majors.

The significance of the course includes: (a) to provide course participants with opportunities to pick up/acquire English oral skills in a natural way; (b) to provide students with additional assistance in their English oral skills learning and to improve their learning achievement; (c) to provide English majors with opportunities to have hands-on experiences in using English and for them to learn to use oral English in real-life situations; (d) to provide the project applicant with the opportunities to evaluate, revise and improve English oral-skill related courses that she is providing to the English majors at the Department.
