## Introduction

This course is designed to explore the core issues and broad trends of Taiwan is political and economic development. At the end of the course students would have the basic ability to analyze Taiwan is politics and economic issues.

This English-taught course aims to enhance the knowledge of students in the fields of politics and economics of Taiwan through an integrated teaching method. Students will be asked “ why ” and “ how ” questions instead of “ what ” and “ who ” ones. The transformation is to elevate students analytical skills essential to their future careers. Students will participate in group discussions each class to elevate their speaking skills. A term paper will help students in research and writing capabilities.

## Outline

This course is a detailed introduction on the history of politics and economics in the ROC. The political history itself can be described a great transformation from colonialism to martial law, then to democratization. Events with great importance allow students to understand the essence of human rights in the history. It is another miracle that Taiwan has transformed its resource exporting economy to a liberalized one. This course also wishes to cultivate the analytical skills of students in comprehending the political and economic issues.
