Introduction

This is an introduction class on basic knowledge of English phonetics and pronunciations. The whole class is divided into three sections, i.e. letters, words and sentences. In the first sections, students will learn how to use the relating organs and methodsto utter an English sound. In the second section, stuents will learn how to put stresses when pronuncing an English word; and finally, students will learn how to apply linking sounds and intonation when reading English sentences. the students will learn some basic theories and mainly real exercises and practices.

The course is designed to let students gain the basic knowledge of English articulatory phonetics. After having studying this course, the students should have the basic knowledge of English consonant, vowel, stress and syllable structures. They should know how to differentiate voiced and voiceless sounds, nasal and non-nasaled sounds related to their vocal organs. And they will gain the knowledge of the relation between English sounds and spellings, which can help them memorize the vocabularies easily.
