Introduction

English Reading Skills is a two-semester course required of all freshman English majors. The first semester course, English Reading Skills I, introduces students to the concepts of reading strategy and critical reading. Students practice these skills in reading tasks based on materials covering a wide range of topics. Tasks include summarizing an article, synthesizing two or more articles (e.g., articles expressing opposing views), locating specific information in a text, distinguishing between fact and opinion, and pinpointing faulty reasoning.

Upon completion of this course, students will demonstrate

- 1. understanding of basic reading strategies, including skimming, scanning, and grasping the main idea
- 2. ability to critically assess the objectivity of reading content
- 3. ability to summarize and present the ideas encountered in reading
- 4. an improved receptive vocabulary resulting from the substantial number of new English words and expressions encountered in course materials
