Introduction

This course selects a few Taiwanese films over the past few decades to reveal major cultural evolution of Taiwan society in the past half century. Among many cultural aspects in Taiwan, the transformation and its historic insides of Taiwanese people in issues like self identification and self respect, from the Japanese colonization, 1980s to 21st century is the core that this course intends to highlight.

Students are anticipated to learn, through this course and the films, not only part of the Taiwanese cultures, but also the means to observe implied cultural and social implications that the films tend to reflect yet not obviously identify. To provide a comparative approach, several foreign films are introduced to build students senses of penetrative when comparing Taiwan 's social and cultural movements with other nations.
