Introduction

Pre-modern and modern English novels refer to the short stories and longer novels selected from these writers that cover 3centuries, from the 18th century to the 21st century. The course is aimed to strengthen students ' language awareness, stylistic appreciation, and interpretative and critical ability, and furthermore to enrich their life experiences, and to enhance their knowledge of and accommodation to the cultures different from their own.

Outline

Advanced English reading and writing abilities are required to satisfy the requirements of the course.

Prerequisite

Students are required to do close-reading and critical interpretation. Translation and briefing are used occasionally to strengthen the command of the language. Both bottom-up and upside-down approaches anre used.
