The basic purpose is to enhance the students' rhetorical sophistication and writing skills, particularly concerning argumentative writing, and to teach an understanding of practical reasoning and rhetorical situations: audience, incident, issue, and cultural context. This goal is achieved by instruction in rhetorical principles and devices and practice in rhetorical analysis of various kinds of documents.
