Introduction

This is the second semester course of English Linguistics. The second semester starts to introduce applied linguistics, including pragmatics, first-language acquisition, second-language acquisition, language variation, neurolinguistics etc.

The goal of the course in the second semester is to let students understand the relation between context and language, the relation between society and language, the process of first language acquisition, the process of second language acquisition, The variation of language and the relation between language and brain.

After completing this course, students will gain the basic knowledge of application of language in many related fields.

Outline

Applied linguistics will be introduced in this semester. It includes the sub-components of linguistics such as pragmatics, first-language acquisition, second-language acquisition, sociolinguistics and neurolinguistics.

- (2) Introducing first-language acquisition
- (3) Introducing second-language acquisition
- (4) Introducing sociolinguistics
- (5) Introducing neurolinguistics
