Introduction

English Literature I & II are to introduce literary texts and historical backgrounds to students. The works discussed include Middle English literary works (in modern easy version), Renaissance dramas (by Marlowe, Spenser and Shakespeare), Enlightenment era works (e.g. Guillver 's travels), Romantic poetry (those of Wordsworth, Coleridge, Shelley, etc.), 19th century fiction (e.g. Wuthering Heights, Jane Eyre, etc.), and 20th century modernist works (e.g. Yeat 's and T.S.Eliot 's poems, etc.). This course is expected to realize the core objectives of our department, with English reading abilities strengthened and also academic researches launched and inspired.

English Literature I is to introduce literary texts and historical backgrounds to students. The time covered is from the Roman Britain (55BC~406AD) to the Tudors (1485~1603), lasting about sixteen hundred years. This course is expected to realize the core objectives of our department: basic English abilities strengthened, English teaching potentials developed, and also academic research launched.
