Introduction

This course aims to close read, analyze and interpret a number of canonical Anglo-American literary texts. Students are required to read and thoroughly understand the assigned text each week before coming to class. Reading and interpretation, especially of literary texts, is the most fundamental and effective training for the mind. It is the key to all intellectual explorations, its importance thus self-evident. As a foreign language literature, however, an Anglo-American literary text often poses great challenges, linguistic as well as cultural, to our students. It is therefore essential that a policy of close reading be adopted for our course so that we do not waste time in a less than thorough effort at reading, much like the legendary Mr. Five Willows. A term paper, to be counted as final exam, is due at the end of the semester.
