<p>. Basic language skills of listening and reading quickly; role-play speaking.(A)</p> <p>2. Ability to use everyday language including commonly used idioms.(B)</p> <p>3. Cultural appreciation of English-speaking countries (C)</p> <p>This course is designed to help students gain the skills they need to use English on a daily basis, especially in terms of listening and reading quickly and gleaning the main ideas and points from the flow of conversation as they pass quickly by in the course of a movie. This is naturally reflective of the speed and language native speakers tend use in their daily life.(A) Discussion about each movie will emphasize the common idioms and everyday speech used in the movie and how it is used in everyday situations; there will be classroom exercises and homework to practice these idioms. (B) Last but not least, in the interest of celebrating unity in diversity, the cultural aspects (which includes humor and pan-cultural understandings), especially the differences but also the similarities between Taiwanese culture and the cultures of English-speaking peoples will be emphasized where necessary.(C)</p>
