Introduction

This course aims to give students the opportunity to enhance significantly their lexical competence, grammatical competence and semantic competence in order to reach a level of proficiency in written French/German sufficient for the students to obtain, at the end of the academic year, the B1 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

Outline

Students will be asked to prepare vocabulary and ideas on a topic decided in advance in order to write, after the in-class preparation work, their own texts.

Students' texts will be available in an electronic file format in order to allow all learners to participate actively and appropriately in the analysis and revision of them.

Students' preparation, as well as the accuracy of their texts, will be assessed every week.

The choice of the topics will help students deal with the major grammatical difficulties in a way that will appeal to their personal experience.

Prerequisite

Students should at least have a level in French/German corresponding to the A2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

Students should be able to:

- (1)understand texts that consist mainly of high frequency everyday language;
- (2)understand the description of events, feelings and wishes in personal texts;
- (3)understand specific, predictable information in simple everyday material such as advertisements, prospectuses, menus and timetables;
- (4) write simple notes and messages relating to matters in areas of immediate need;
- (5) write simple connected texts on topics which ar
