Introduction

Listening and Speaking I is designed to improve your listening and speaking skills through intensive practice. We will explore basic strategies for planning and taking part in group discussions and presentations. The course will include presentations, speeches, and group discussions. A variety of listening materials, including authentic materials from online sources such as Youtube may also be used.

Outline

The goal of this course is to improve your conversational ability (your listening and speaking) through intensive practice. Our work will be divided into several units, each based on a different theme. The course work will be done either individually or in small groups. In each unit, we will do a variety of speaking activities related to the unit theme, such as short speeches, presentations and group discussions. We may also do other activities to help you reach the listening goals of each unit. Some of the activities may be done either online or through computerised practice.

Prerequisite

This course is designed for first year English majors. No special background or prerequisite courses are required.
